- Elections of At-Large Members Discussion **Info Item**
  - SB too short of notice with Beach and Bay press to make at-large elections since they have to get signatures – we can select a date and then send out the notice to the Beach and Bay press to allow people time to collect signatures
  - JC do we have to collect signatures as current members?
    - SB – no, only new members. There is only a vacancy in the Southwest Quadrant.
  - SB will confirm with Katie Matchett (Northwest) if she wants to vacate her spot or stay.
  
- City Residential Parking Permit Program Update **Info Item**
  - M. Eslamian – if we get the next date for next Feb, she can pretty much guarantee that they have a parking commission rep present
  - J. Corcozza – asked about the amount of tax revenue taken out of PB to be used for programming in Pacific Beach
  - M. Eslamian – confirmed that information is not collected, residents can use public records request for information or FOIA however a lot of money from the City does go back into the beach area.
  - S. Berns – DPB tried to get this information through a voluntary request from businesses but was too inaccurate

- A. Huntington – asked about the potential for waiving the permit fee
  - M. Eslamian – believe for the first year it can be waived but it's \$12/year after
  - General discussion on projects parking money could go towards, and pros and cons of parking meters.
  - S. Berns updated the group on Garnet Vision and that the overall goal is to make Garnet Ave safer for pedestrians, cyclist and cars to coexist. There is no one solution being proposed.
