### Introductions/Sign in

#### Chair Report

**R.Sinsky Crosby we have another B&B Press article coming out. Thinking about creating ad hoc committees. If and when we have money, what will our priorities be? Would like to vote on those by the next meeting.**

**R.Sinsky Crosby postponed the review and approval minutes from October 13, 2020 Parking meeting. So that folks have more time to read those. Will approve at the next meeting.**

#### Presentation on City process on implementation, budget and removal

- S. Berns presented and FAQ with information from the City regarding implementation and removal of meters as well as how funds are managed
- B Curry brought up issue with DPB administrative costs
- K. Matchett asked where the administrative cost of DPB would come from, the city or the parking district funding?
  - S. Berns said it would come out the parking district funding
  - KM suggests that we should have an estimate of those.
  - SB I don't think the administrative side is high, she can look at what the administrative costs are for Little Italy, or other districts
  - There was discussion on the budget process and that Parking District budget would be approved by the Advisory board then included with Discover PB budget for approval from the City Council each year.
  - G. Froehlich asked if we would have a checking account with the city?
    - SB explained the city works on a reimbursement system so the cost is reimbursed and we submit the invoices that they reimburse. An organization must be able to operate the projects and fund them to be reimbursed.
    - RSC stated this FAQ should be posted on the website.
    - J. Bettles asked based on answers from City, , what is the timeline we are seeing in starting the pilot and seeing the meters up once it's approved?
      - SB said it depends on when the council will docket it which there is no guarantee and its up to the council president at that point after this board approves it.
      - M. Tello likely not this December, maybe Feb or March being ambitious it would be on the docket.
      - K. Matchette - Don't we have to go through Coastal Commission?
      - A. Huntington said the coastal commission has said it doesn't have to when he asked before but this is best case scenario timing
      - M. Tello Adam is right, it would have to be fully supported by the community and the board.
      - S. Berns asked what the process would be for submitting a budget to the City this fiscal year if approval happened during that time line?
      - MT said she has never dealt with this before and she will have to check with the city staff on this question and bring it back.

#### Presentation on shuttle and mobility option

- J. Bettles presented information on shuttle opportunity (attached)
- B. Curry this is what we have been talking about forever. Joe, excellent. He has also talked to SANDAG about expanding public transit to cover the last mile to PB.
- KM it's also on the beautifulPB website. Joe it seems like they have an on demand model, but do they have a route model option also?
- JB they are not set on anything. It goes anywhere from 10 places to the fully on demand.
- GF would MTS want to run it for us for a better price?
- SB – planning group and other committees have spoken to MTS about a shorter route for the beach area to connect to the trolley but currently the plan is to include an OB/PB loop from what she understood
- RSC I think it would be worth having MTS answer questions.
- E. Anderson - really you don't want to spend all of your money on this type of project from parking. This is flexible and you don't want to pin it down. I love the project and thank you Joe for the presentation.
- RSC this is an ongoing discussion.

### **Pilot Parking Program**

- Review community outreach and feedback
- DPB
  - T. Pruesener Discover PB voted in favor of the Paid Parking Program
  - SB presented the updated feedback that has come into the email. She also shared a document with all of DPB outreach efforts and updated businesses surveyed 14 supportive businesses in the pilot area, 0 not, and 1 unsure and a remainder have not responded

### **PBTC**

- B. Curry stated the PBTC Board voted unanimously in support of the Paid Parking Program
- BC the list of outreach should be put into the presentation.
- PBPG
  - J. Bettles the item was heard and postponed to this months meeting as the board was still unsure and has more questions
- beautifulPB
  - We came out in support early of this program. One thing she was going to ask about the spreadsheet, it might be helpful to have a summary with general concepts that are repeated throughout if someone has time to do that.
- GF no feedback at this point from his section
- AH has about 300 people in his group and has no negative feedback on paid parking
  - Kevin Vincent -I had noticed in previous presentations those Dawes and Everts streets are not 2-hour spots.
  - GF on Bayard street there is no 2 hour parking on Bayard from Hornblend to la jolla
- Updates to pilot program/presentation if any and community outreach plan continued
  - Add the outreach number of the businesses
  - Add the map of the Dawes and and Everts removed
  - BC said the math should be amended to represent new map and number of spaces
  - *T. Pruesener motioned to approve, K. Matchette endorsed the motion. Motion passes 7/0/1*
