- 3) Non-Agenda Public Comment
  - a) G. Daunoras – Has received a request through the Planning Group that he will forward to the Parking Advisory Board.
- 4) Committee Member Comment
  - a) E. Marenburg – Commented on new stop sign on Thomas and recommended a similar sign on Thomas.
- 5) Grand Avenue Request to change white zone to 15 min parking – Claudia Brizuela, City of San Diego
  - a) Discussion on request. No quorum for this meeting, group was unable to vote.
- 6) Update on Parking Meter Pilot Program (Info Item) – Krystal Ayala, City of San Diego
  - a) The City will be conducting the parking duration study. Currently searching for a consultant to complete the study. The desire is that the study will show 85% usage.
  - b) Any changes to rates or hours needs approval from City Council.
  - c) Parking Pilot
    - i) Q: How do we know if the pilot is successful?
    - ii) Q: Can the group set metrics of success?
    - iii) The counts and duration study will identify the success and ideally should reveal 85% utilization.

  - a) Service demands have dipped since summer. There have been changes to service hours with more potential changes to come as needs change.

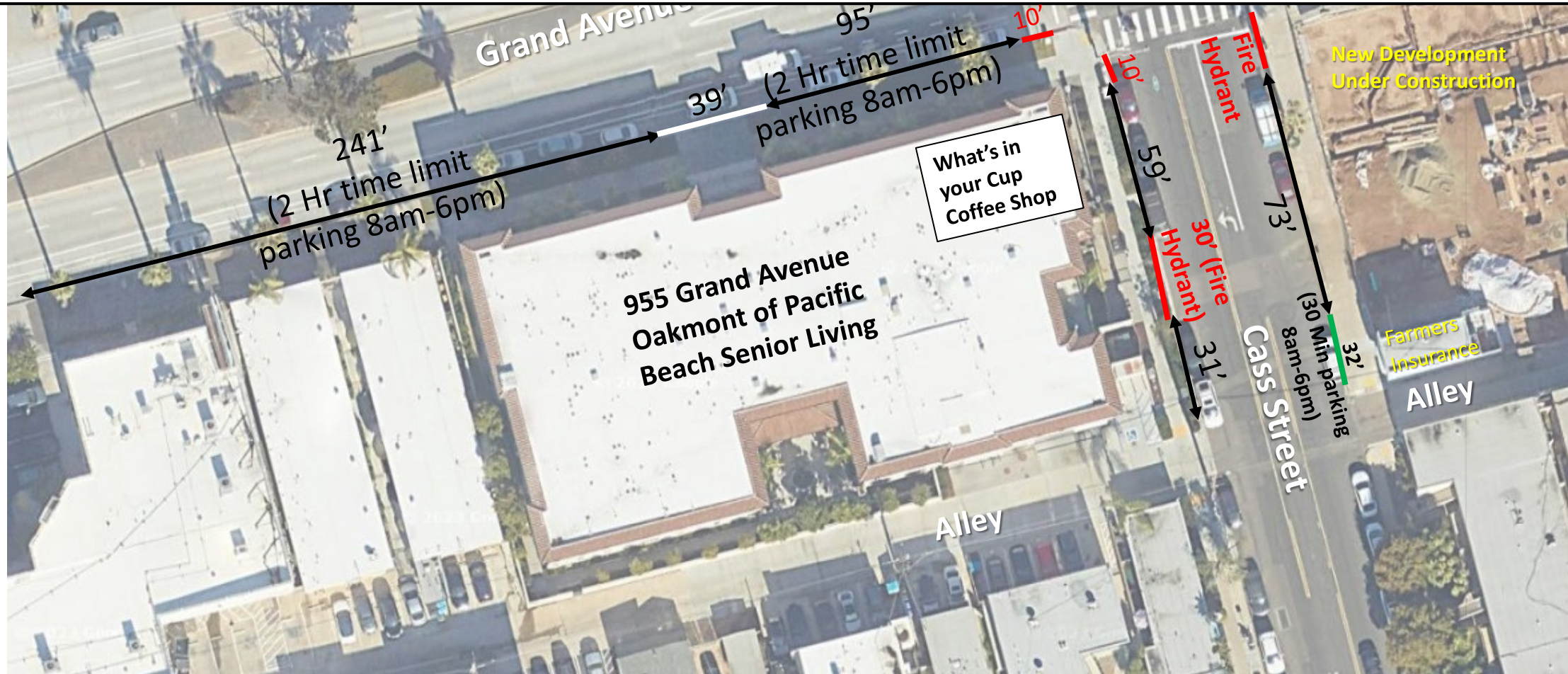
- 8) PB Pathways AdHoc Committee Update – Katie Matchett

**Request** is to install two 15-minute short term parking spaces along Cass Street fronting the “What’s in your cup?” coffee shop for customers to park and pick up their coffee orders. Coffee Shop hours: 8am-4pm Tuesday-Friday, 8am-2pm Sat& Sun

**Recommendation** is to install two 15-minute short term parking spaces (~44’) during the hours 8am-4pm (typical hours is 8am-6pm). Parking along Cass Street is unregulated (meaning no time limit). Area is heavily parked due to proximity to beach. Oakmont of PB has underground parking garage for tenants. There is one existing short term parking space (30 min) nearby across the street fronting Farmers Insurance,

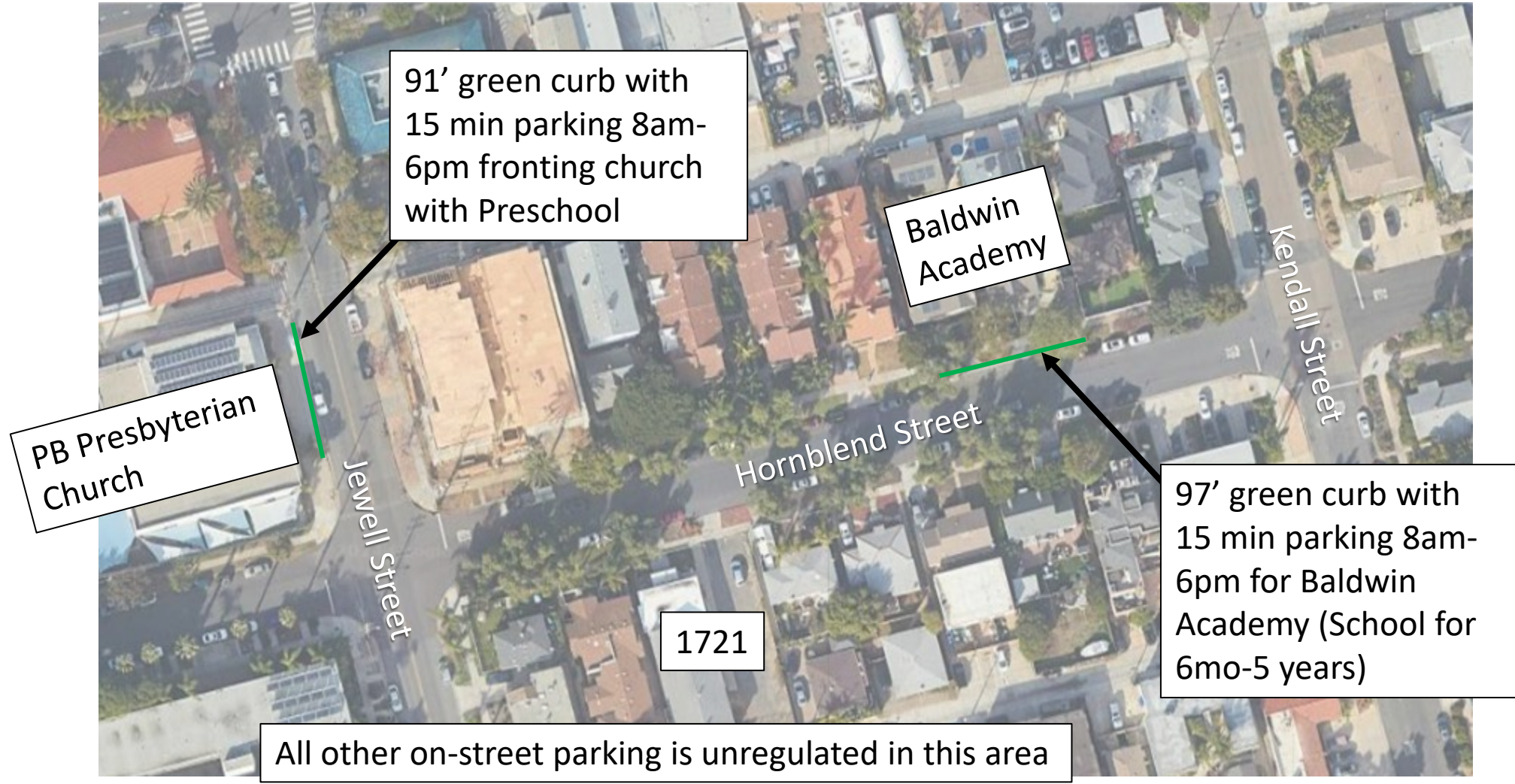




### Diagram for CPD Discussion:

**Request** is to install one 3-minute passenger loading zone and one 30-minute short term parking space fronting the California Zoroastrian Center at 1721 Hornblend Street.

**Recommendation** is to install one passenger loading zone and one short term parking of 30 minutes





Although the Church/Center has off-street parking and access to alley, neighbors in alley have expressed concerns with vehicles exiting from parking lot and turning too close to their parked vehicle. Saturdays and Tuesdays the Center hosts Activities for senior adults. Many seniors get dropped off and picked up for church and events. 3-minute passenger loading zone will help many and the short-term parking (green curb) will help those who need assistance getting walked in to center.

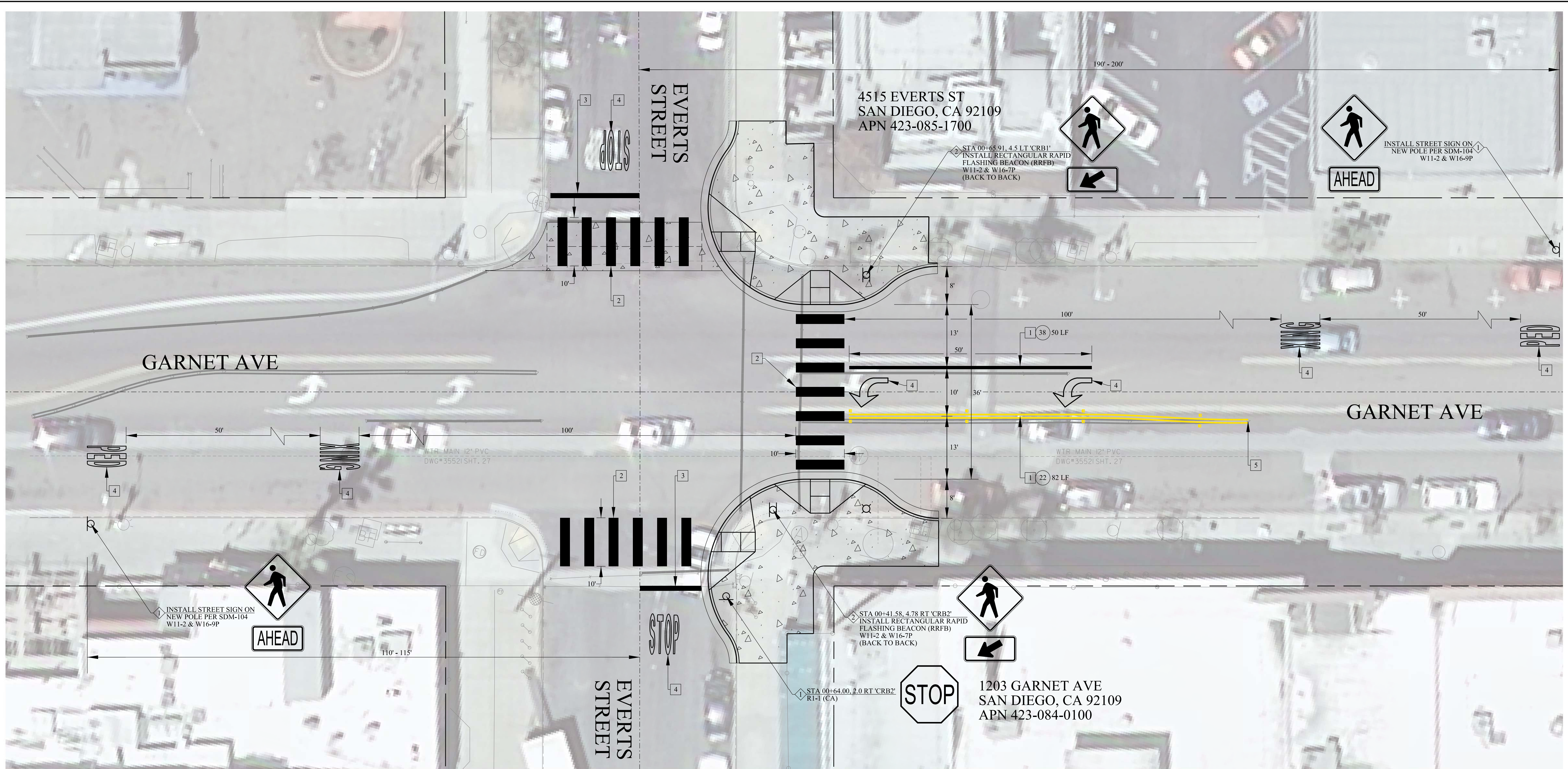

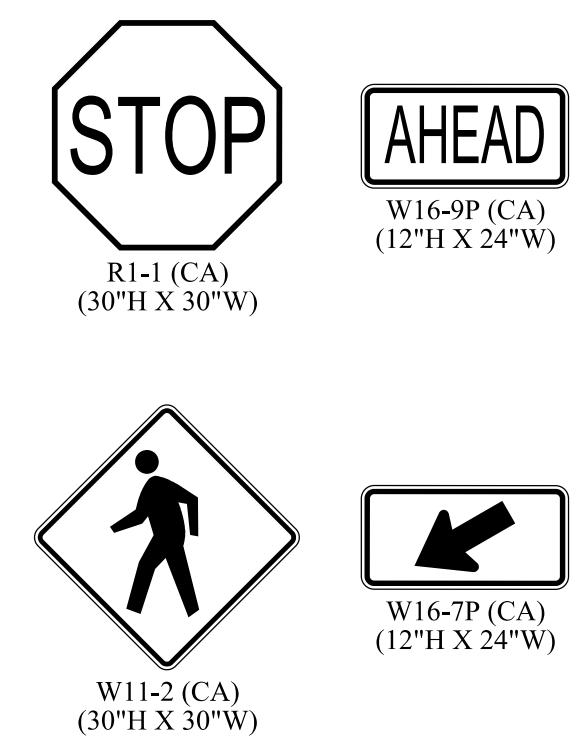

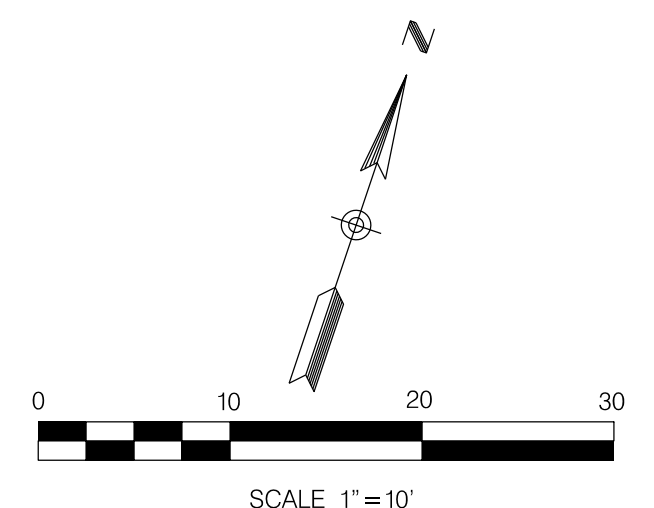
